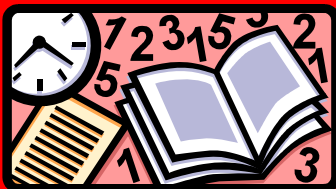

EMPLOYERS CAN GAIN ADDITIONAL RESOURCES FROM SOLUTIONS GROUP

The River Valley Workforce Investment Board has helped organize a new Business Solutions Group to assist local employers with a variety of services.

The River Valley Business Solutions Group is supported by participation from the Illinois Department of Employment Security, Waubensee Community College and others, all of whom have representatives available to work with businesses through the North Aurora Illinois Employment & Training Center located at 2 Smoke Tree Plaza, in North Aurora.

A number of businesses already use the IETC for their workforce recruitment activities. Largely, the office allows employers to utilize the resources of the IDES staff to perform job searches to assist in staffing efforts. The office also works extensively with temporary help and staffing services on behalf of other employers.

The Business Solutions Group was organized to provide employers with additional resources. The group will meet with employers and organize services such as the customary job search. In addition, they are prepared to provide job search assistance for families relocating to a new community; an array of prepaid staffing services; customized labor market information; and offer critical career skill training in communication, problem-solving, critical thinking, teamwork and effective work behaviors.

At the IETC's, the Business Solutions Group can offer staffing support for large-scale and smaller hiring events, scheduling assistance for a pre-screened applicant pool, and interviewing facilities that will support the employer's need for a professional selection effort.

The River Valley Workforce Investment Board staff is certain that it can help employers with a variety of business solutions.
