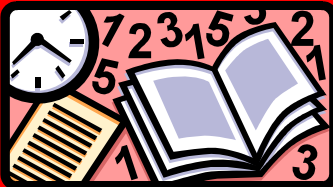

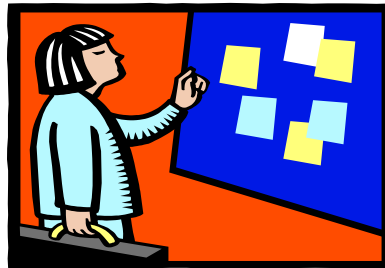

Businesses Sought For “FREE RESEARCH”



Aurora University associate professor of marketing Shawn Green is seeking eight area companies to receive free help from business students in his **Marketing Research** course that began January 11th. A three-student team is assigned to each business partner for assisting that firm with marketing research. Under Dr. Green’s tutelage, collegians will conduct surveys of 100 or more customers of each firm.

Working with company officials, teams will develop research proposals, collect survey questionnaire data, analyze data, and write a research report based on findings. Final research reports will include an executive summary of key findings, and students will provide an overview of research projects they conduct. 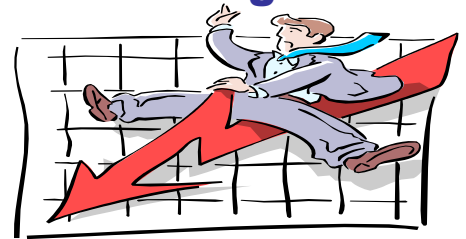
