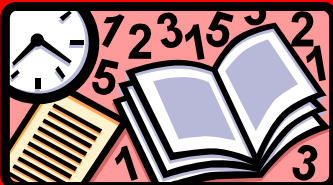

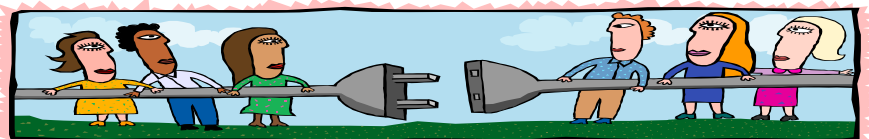

New Provena Medical Offices and

New Home for Dreyer Medical Clinic In Yorkville



The Yorkville EDC is pleased to announce a new medical office building that is being built through a partnership with Dreyer Medical Clinic and Provena Mercy Center. Yorkville will be the home to a new state of the art 22,000 square foot medical office building. The facility will be located on Route 34 near Sycamore on approximately 5 acres of land. This project is being developed by, and will be owned by, Healthcare Development Partners. It will be the new home to Dreyer Medical Clinic, and will open in the fall of 2005. The commitment to Yorkville by Dreyer Medical Clinic has been expressed by pledging themselves to keeping Yorkville families healthy and well, as they have for over 80 years throughout the Fox Valley. Dreyer will utilize 6,500 square feet of the building. The remaining 13,500 square feet will be occupied by Provena Mercy Center.
