Group packages and birthday parties are available at discount rates that will be available for groups with advance reservations.

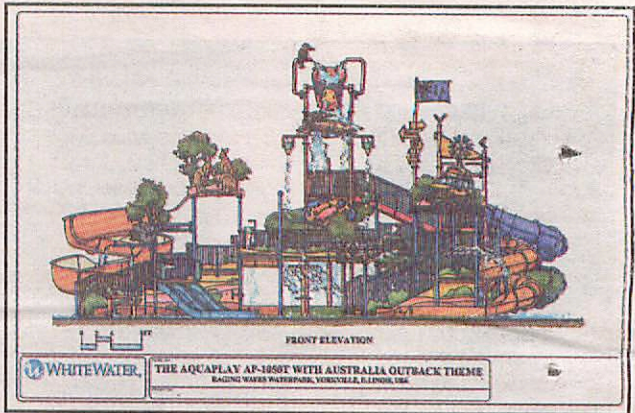
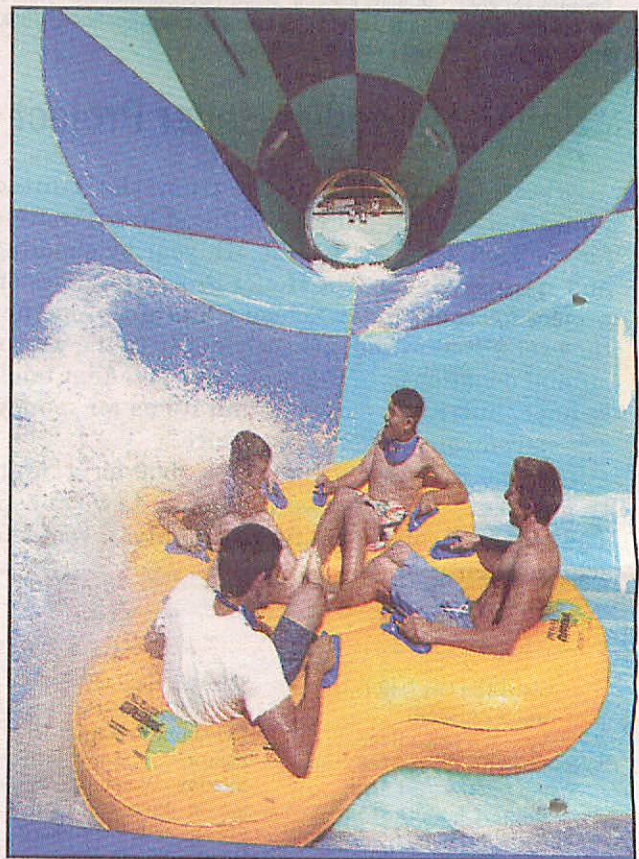


Illustration of what the interactive water play structure "Outback Falls" will look like.
